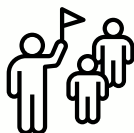

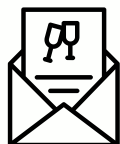

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



### What are the accommodations like?

Travelers stay in a local hotel. Sheets, towels, and a pillow are provided. Hot water and air conditioning are available. WIFI will be available sporadically throughout the trip.



### Where will we eat? What if I have a food allergy?

Travelers will sample culinary specialties of Juticalpa. Meals may be enjoyed at the retreat center, as a picnic, in a restaurant, or even in the home of a community member. Vegetarian options can be offered if requested in advance. Those with food allergies should discuss restrictions with us before their trip to determine the type of accommodations that can be made.



### How is Olancho Aid taking COVID into consideration?

Olancho Aid continues to monitor the state of the COVID-19 pandemic in Honduras and abroad. Appropriate precautions will be taken to keep travelers, staff and community members safe. Proof of vaccination and boosters (as recommended by the CDC) are required at least two weeks before departure. As the situation continues to change, expectations will be communicated to participants the week before their departure and adjusted upon arrival if needed. Travelers should bring masks as they are still being used in many settings in Honduras.
